## Made in Dagenham

\*Running time: 113 Minutes

A dramatization of the 1968 strike at Britain's Ford Dagenham car plant, in which female workers walked out in protest against sexual discrimination, *Made in Dagenham* follows newbie union representative Rita (Sally Hawkins, *An Education*, *Happy-Go-Lucky*) and her female co-workers as they tirelessly take their grievance to the highest powers in the land.

In reality, these women were directly responsible for equal pay legislation across the globe – no small feat during any era, especially in the male-dominated world of late 1960s Britain.

Director Nigel Cole (*Saving Grace*, *Calendar Girls*) expertly weaves history with drama, concentrating not only on the actual strike and political reactions, but on the individual families and the women themselves. And it is here where Cole really stands out, conveying the warmth shared between family, friends and colleagues, especially during tough times. Pic features Miranda Richardson in a wonderful performance as the British Minister of Labour and Bob Hoskins (*Mrs. Henderson Presents*) as a sympathetic union steward.

With its inspiring true story and tight script by wunderkind Billy Ivory, *Made in Dagenham* is the ultimate date movie for the feminist in your life.
